

Krugerville Residents:

Please remember, the Quarterly Bulk pickup is scheduled for April 18, 2020. Please have your items curbside no later than 7:00 am. Please note the following:

- All brush, newspapers, tree trimmings, branches, wood and fencing must be bundled and cut into no more than 4 ft lengths. All nails must be removed (if “construction” type material). Bundles can weigh no more than 35 pounds.
- All appliances (having refrigerant, coolant, or Freon) must be drained by a licensed HVAC professional, certified and tagged with the information that the State requires.
- Lawn equipment must be drained of all gas and oil.
- Remove the lids on all cans containing paint or stain. They must be completely dry on the inside. Cat litter or sand can be helpful with this process.
- Carpet must be cut down to lengths of 4 ft or less, be rolled and tied, and weigh no more than 35 pounds.
- Total bulk volume cannot exceed 2 cubic yards.
- Tires, batteries, and concrete will not be picked up.

Since many of our residents have been a part of the recent shelter-in-place order, our trash provider, Waste Connections, has experienced a 30% increase in weekly residential trash pickup. These increases have resulted in lengthy stops at residences, more frequent offloads at the landfill, and longer days for the Waste Connection employees.

At this time, we request that you hold all bulk items until the quarterly pickups. Their focus on Wednesday’s will continue to be residential trash and they must be able to complete their route within the day.
